

30 January

Workshop organised with primary school pupils, aiming to make them understand the mechanism of a conflict, types of conflicts and the various forms of violence, in order to make them become aware about the reactions that may lead to a violent denouement and, on the contrary, what are the non-violent solutions to any dispute

7 February

Interactive mini-debate on “How do I react when facing a conflict?” The starting point was a fictitious conflicting situation, while the participants were offered five types of solutions of which they were supposed to choose the one that best fitted them

13 February – 13 March

Celebration of the Safer Internet Day, an event organised with the students of two eighth forms from Secondary School “Prof. Ion Vişoiu” with the purpose of making the students realise the potential danger the virtual world – search engines, online games, socialising networks, chat pages – may pose to children’s rights

21 February

On the International Mother Language Day RIHR, in collaboration with School No. 97 in Bucharest, conceived and organised an interactive workshop addressing primary school children

20 April

Event devoted to Earth Day (22 April), mainly focusing on the limitation of pollution with plastic waste, in the larger context of the requirement to protect the environment

10 May

Session of dissertations and debates on human rights, the European values and the future of the youth in the European Union, organised at National College “Octav Onicescu” in Bucharest on occasion of Europe Day

14 May – The International Humanitarian Day in Romania – was marked by means of an event devoted to the Great Union Centennial on “International Humanitarian Law. Romanian cultural patrimony, traditions and values in the Year of the Great Union Centennial, whose purpose was to raise awareness of the responsible authorities at all levels regarding the need to protect mankind’s cultural and spiritual patrimony

On 15 May, on occasion of the International Day of Families, Economic College “Virgil Madgearu” in Ploieşti hosted an event on “The family: educators and human rights providers”, organised by the Romanian Institute for Human Rights in partnership with Foundation “Adolescența” and the Economic College “Virgil Madgearu”, Ploieşti

16 May

The partnership concluded between RIHR and the Municipal Library of Bucharest was the occasion of a first meeting in an intended series of informing sessions addressed to parents, meant to raise awareness about a number of topical issues

having impact upon the daily life of juveniles. The Seminar's theme was children's rights in the virtual world and was organised by RIHR at "Nichita Stănescu" Agency of the of the Municipal Library of Bucharest

30 May

The Romanian Institute for Human Rights participated in the sessions of the National Symposium entitled "STOP Bullying. Say NO to intimidation – examples of good practices", organised in partnership by the Cluj County School Inspectorate, the Teachers' Training Centre in Cluj, and the Centre of Educational Resources and Assistance in Cluj

5 June – The World Environment Day was marked by the Romanian Institute for Human Rights by means of an event organised in partnership with Foundation "Adolescența" on "The planet needs a healthy environment" attended by 9th grade students and their guiding teachers

14 June

"The living library – Don't judge a book by its covers" is the suggestive name of the informal education event organised by the Europe Direct Information Centre in Bucharest under the European Institute of Romania, in collaboration with the Romanian Institute for Human Rights and in partnership with the Metropolitan Library in Bucharest as well as Humanitarian Organisation Concordia (through United Way) and the Special Technologic High School No. 3 in Bucharest – the 'suppliers' of the participating living books
